The Purpose The 4 Friends Shared: *Getting Their Friend to Jesus*

- ~The power of the Lord was present for Jesus to heal
- ~No better place than Jesus presence
- ~Being with disciples
- ~Hearing Jesus teach the Word

The Problems They Had to Overcome:
