All Kinds Of Prayer

Adoration: To praise and worship God for who He is

"Praise the LORD, O my soul. O LORD my God, you are very great; you are clothed with splendor and majesty."

Ps 104:1

All Kinds Of Prayer

Confession: To agree with God that my behavior is wrong and seek His forgiveness.

"If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness."

1John 1:9

All Kinds Of Prayer

Thanksgiving: To thank God for His provision and blessing in our life.

"I will exalt you, O LORD, for you lifted me out of the depths and did not let my enemies gloat over me.

O LORD my God, I called to you for help and you healed me.

O LORD, you brought me up from the grave; you spared me from going down into the pit."

Psalm 30:1-3

All Kinds Of Prayer

Supplication: To ask God for something we or others need

*"Hear me, O God, as I voice my complaint; protect my life
from the threat of the enemy.*

*Hide me from the conspiracy of the wicked, from that noisy
crowd of evildoers."*

Psalm 64:1-2

All Kinds Of Prayer

Intercession: To be the “go between” for someone else with God, praying on their behalf

“O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, you who kill the prophets and stone those sent to you, how often I have longed to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, but you were not willing.”

Matthew 23:37

All Kinds Of Prayer

Prayer of Faith: To pray believing something you ask for is yours before you see it

*"Then Jesus looked up and said, "Father, I thank you that you have heard me. I knew that you always hear me, but I said this for the benefit of the people standing here, that they may believe that you sent me." When he had said this, Jesus called in a loud voice, "Lazarus, come out!"
The dead man came out..."*

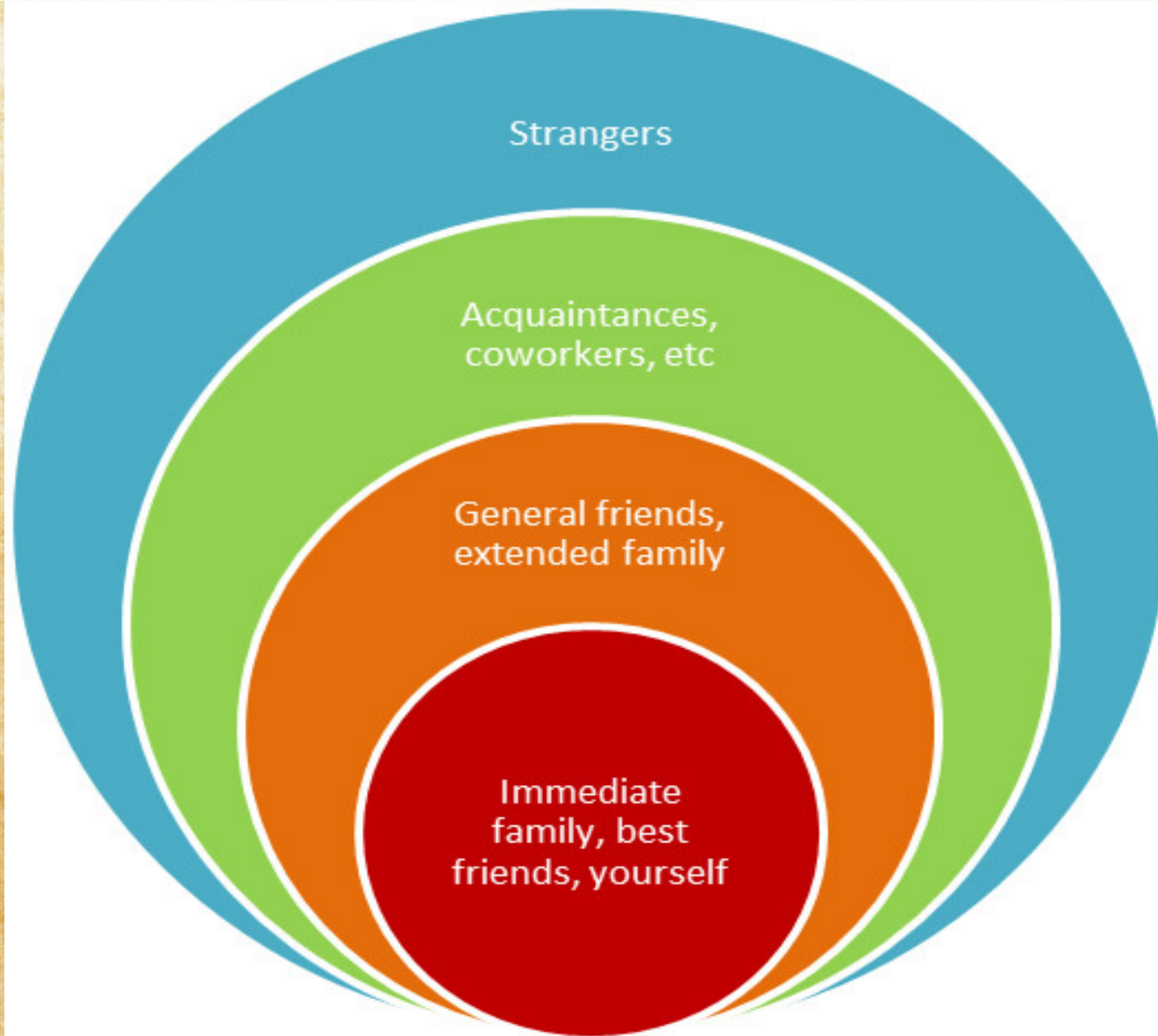
