I FEEL I'M CALLED TO GO ... NOW WHAT?

If you feel God calling you to participate as a team member on the mission journey outlined in this brochure, or to any other location, there are steps you need to take that will help you be well prepared for your mission journey experience:

STEP #1: CONTACT THE MISSIONS LEADERSHIP TEAM

We are here to help you and be an encouragement to you as you prepare to **GO** on a mission journey. We can only do this if we know your interest to be on a specific team. Contact us as soon as you sense God's leading, and we will process with you where God is leading you.

STEP #2: SUBMIT THE APPLICATION & DEPOSIT

Submitting the application and deposit are signs of commitment and are needed detail as we assemble our teams. Submitting the application does not guarantee a spot on the team, as we check references and pray about the teams, but it is an imperative and required step. Personal interviews with the trip leader are also scheduled with potential team members as needed (all youth **must** interview with Pastor Joey and/or Charlene).

STEP #3: OBTAIN A PASSPORT

If you sense a call to a location beyond our borders, go ahead and secure a passport. This, too, is a step of faith, signifying you are ready to **GO** as God so directs.

STEP #4: PREPARE SPIRITUALLY

- 1) Maintain a growing relationship with Jesus Christ.
- 2) Practice the disciplines of Bible study and prayer.
- 3) Pray about all aspects of your and your team's missions trip.
- 4) Start and maintain a journal - map your journey.
- 5) Respond to mission opportunities, even at home
- 6) Let your interest be known to others so they can pray with you.
