Remember and Recount God's Past Faithfulness

He has...

- *Listened to me: to lean over and pay attention*
- *Heard my cry: to hear intelligently*
- *Lifted me from trouble: Picked me up and out!*
- *Given me a new song: A fresh, new original song*

Continue To Honor Him In The Present

As you wait...

- *Don't just "go through the motions" of worship*
- *Instead give Him honest and sincere devotion (Ex 22:1ff)*
- *Testify to His faithfulness*
 - > *Proclaim*
 - > *Don't seal your lips*
 - > *Don't hide or conceal His work*
 - > *Speak of His faithfulness*

Trust Him For The Future

As you wait...

- *Don't let your spiritual guard down*
- *Trust Him to protect you*
- *Don't allow new problems to move your focus and faith*
- *Recognize your ongoing need for God*
