have you do this, ⁵ because he loves our nation and has built our synagogue." ⁶ So Jesus went with them.

He was not far from the house when the centurion sent friends to say to him: "Lord, don't trouble yourself, for I do not deserve to have you come under my roof.

Luke 7:1-10 cont'd

⁷ That is why I did not even consider myself worthy to come to you. But say the word, and my servant will be healed. ⁸ For I myself am a man under authority, with soldiers under me. I tell this one, 'Go,' and he goes; and that one, 'Come,' and he comes. I say to my servant, 'Do this,' and he does it."

Luke 7:1-10 cont'd

⁹ When Jesus heard this, he was amazed at him, and turning to the crowd following him, he said, "I tell you, I have not found such great faith even in Israel."¹⁰ Then the men who had been sent returned to the house and found the servant well.

Jesus in Capernaum

- Lived there after temptation

- Found a number of His disciples in that area

- Performed various miracles



Roman Military

Legion had 5,000-6,000 men

Legion = 10 Cohorts

Cohort = 6 Centuria

Centuria = 100 Legionnaires



Centurion Duties

- Supervise fortifications
- Escort prisoners
- Relay orders down the line
- Lead men into battle
- Punished troops

- Served as a bridge between officers and troops
