Moses Excuse: I'm not good enough! Vs 11

God's Reply: I will be with you. Vs 12

Moses Excuse: I'm don't know enough! Vs 13

God's Reply: Go tell them about Me. Vs 14-15

The God of their fathers, Abraham, Isaac and Jacob!
The God you don't know...but who wants to know YOU!



Moses Excuse: People won't believe me! Vs 13

God's Reply: I will give them a sign. 4:1-9

God has given our generation a "sign" His Son, His Word "No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him..."

John 6:44



Moses Excuse: I'm not good with words! 4:10

God's Reply:

I will speak through you. 4:10-12 I will teach you what to say I will give you Aaron!
