"Don't you know that when you offer yourselves to someone to obey him as slaves, <u>you are slaves to the one whom you obey-</u>- whether you are slaves to sin, which leads to death, or to obedience, which leads to righteousness?

But thanks be to God that, though you used to be slaves to sin, you wholeheartedly obeyed the form of teaching to which you were entrusted.

You have been set free from sin and have become slaves to righteousness.

I put this in human terms because you are weak in your natural selves. Choose The Right Master Gal 5:1

- Without Christ we are slaves to sin
- Some are slaves to self-imposed expectations
- Some are slaves to others' expectations
- Some are slaves to work, culture, the pursuit of wealth, power or influence.

Choice # 1: Choose To Serve Christ!

Galatians 5:1

"It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery."

"...you are slaves to the one whom you obey... so now offer them (parts of your body) in slavery to righteousness leading to holiness."

Make The Right Choice: Christ Alone Gal 5:2-9

• Do NOT accept any cheap substitute for Grace

- Do NOT sacrifice the power of the Spirit for the works of the flesh
- Do NOT believe any promise of righteousness other than through faith and faith alone.

Choice # 2: Choose Christ Alone!

God's Work In You

•Justification: Declared righteous

Sanctification: Becoming righteous

"Christ will provide unlimited help to those who place their undivided trust in Him, but no help at all to those who bypass His saving work and think to become acceptable to God by any other means!"

•Glorification: Made righteous!



Choose To Serve God And Others Gal 5:13-15

Do not use your freedom to serve self (flesh)
Do not use your freedom to criticize and critique others. (Judiazers)

• Use your freedom to be like Jesus.
