PARDON: Seek God's Forgiveness And Mercy

- Genesis 3: Adam and Eve
 - >Hide; Fear God; Blame Shift; Excuse
- Psalm 51: David Chose Differently
 - Confessed His sin
 - >Asked for Forgiveness
 - > Pled for restored Forgiveness

"Come now, let us reason together," says the LORD. "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red as crimson, they shall be like wool." Is 1:18

RESTORATION: Pray for God To Restore The Consequences of Sin

Vs 8: Let me hear joy and gladness

· Vs 10: Create in me a clean heart

Vs 10: Renew a steadfast love within me

Vs 11: Do not remove Your Spirit from me

Vs 12: Grant me a willing spirit

· Vs 14: Deliver me from guilt

PRAISE: A Promise To Praise God When He Delivers You

Teach: I will teach others of your grace

Declare: I will tell everyone what you have done and

will sing your praises!

Honor: I will honor you with true repentance and

not meaningless ritual

Pray: I will pray for my sin to not have

consequences in the life of others.

Today Consider:

- Seeking God's forgiveness for unconfessed sin in your life
- Seeking a relationship with God by confessing your sin and accepting Christ as your Savior and Lord.
