C. Why would God design it this way?

While each believer has specific gifts, all the gifts serve one primary
purpose. They are intended to God. A spiritual gift is given to
each of us so we can help each other. (1 Corinthians 12:7, New Living
Translation)
God's various gifts are handed out everywhere; but they all in
