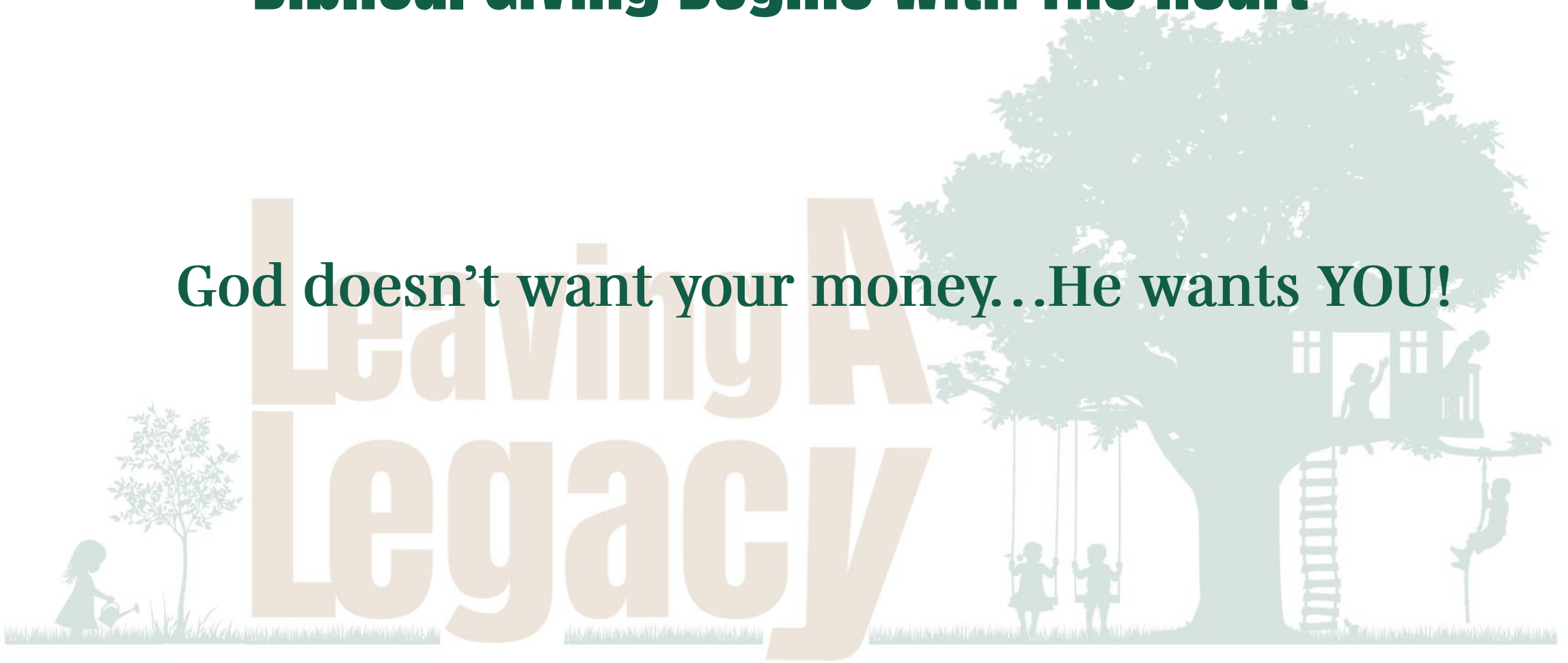
Biblical Giving Is A Privilege, Not An Obligation Or Burden

God doesn't want your money..He wants YOU!

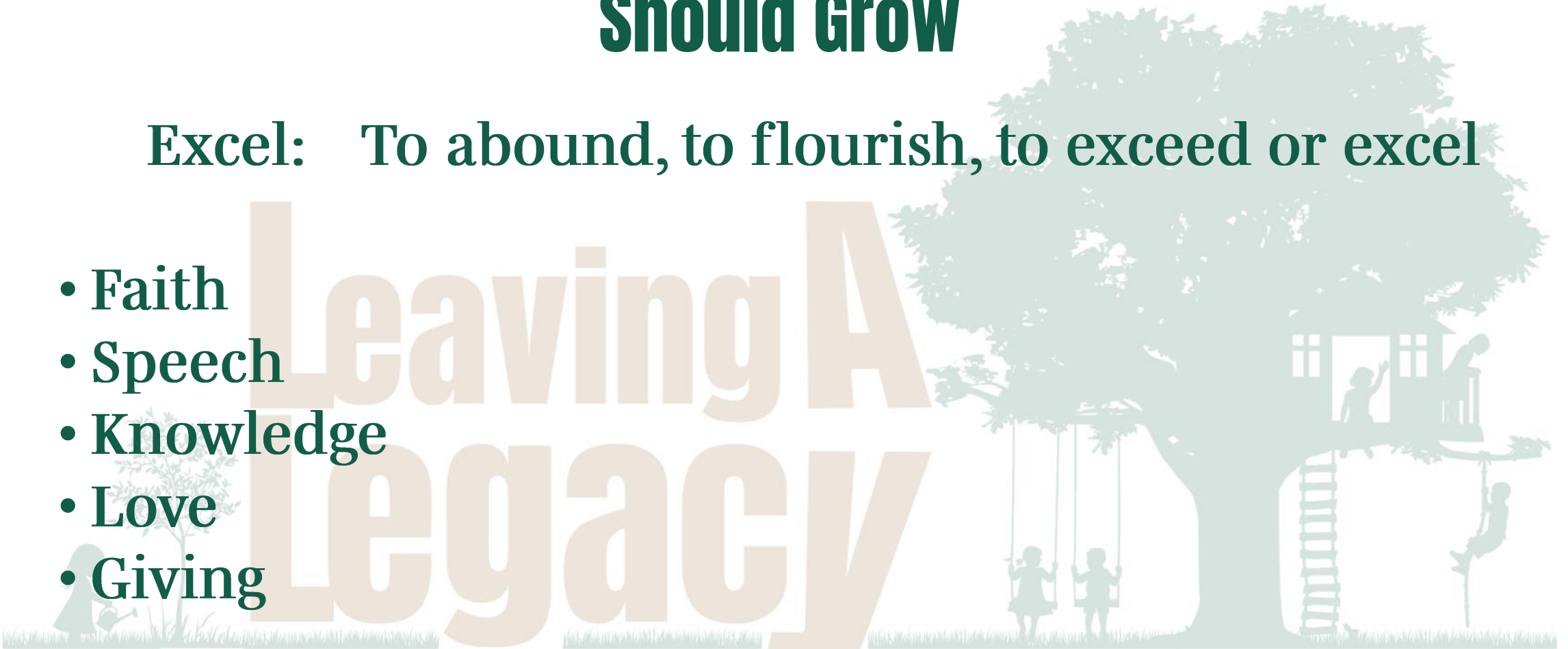


Biblical Giving Is A Spiritual Discipline In Which You Should Grow

Biblical Giving Is A Test Of The Sincerity Of Your Love

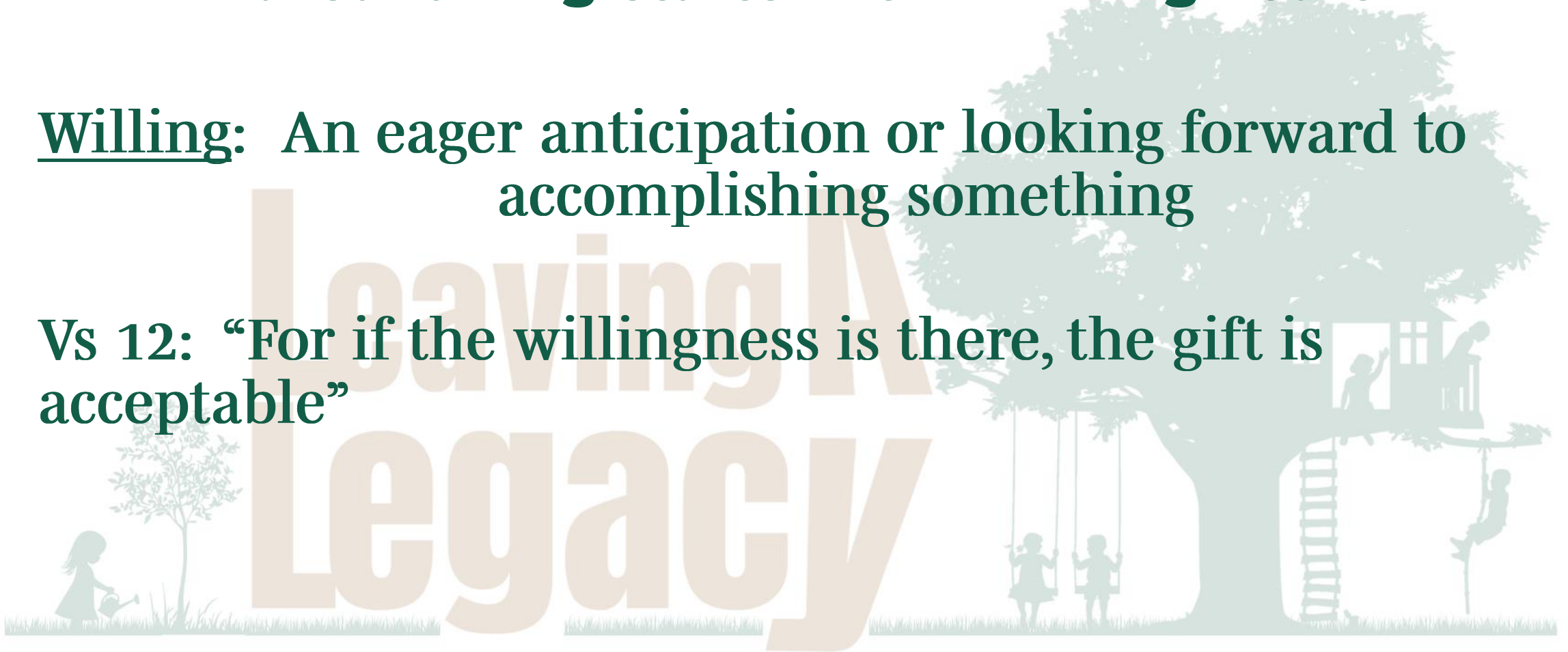
God, I love you, but only as far as it extends to YOU

Biblical Giving Starts With A Willing Heart
